



short term: interactive mapping platform of community spaces under threat with links towards bubbling campaigns.


mid term: to produce a collaborative map through public workshops to highlight communities assets and projects, while connecting actors campaigning for a fairer London.


long term: to create a meta mapping platform to collect all kind of data produced by London communities and useful for a London community-led planning.




